 - (1) Exchange of the faculty and staff
 - (2) Exchange of students
 - (3) Promotion of joint research projects
 - (4) Exchange of research reports, publications and academic information
 - (5) Other activities by mutual agreement
- 2. RMUTT and YU shall collaborate to prepare a detailed program when executing each of the above activities
- 3. This MOU shall be valid for a period of five years commencing on the date of its signing by the representatives of both universities. The agreement may be automatically renewed every five years, unless either party wishes to terminate the agreement. Renewal and termination of the agreement will be decided upon mutual consent.
- This MOU is executed in duplicate in English, with both texts being equally authentic.

AGREEMENT ON STUDENT EXCHANGE BETWEEN

RAJAMANGALA UNIVERSITY OF TECHNOLOGY THANYABURI



AND

YAMAGATA UNIVERSITY



Rajamangala University of Technology Thanyaburi (RMUTT) and Yamagata University (YU) shall verify the following clauses in connection with implementation of exchange students program based on the bilateral cooperation agreement.

- Each university may send and accept at most two students each year. The duration of stay for the students at either host university shall be from six months to one year.
- 2. Each university, conforming to the admission requirements of the host university, shall assume full responsibility in the assessment and selection of qualified candidates.
- 3. All exchange students shall be subject to the same academic regulations regarding class performance as pertain to regularly enrolled students at the host institution.
- The host university shall exempt the students exchanged from paying entrance examination, admission and tuition fees.
- 5. Students exchanged will be responsible for all other expenses, including their own transportation to and from the host university, all room and board related costs, living expenses, health insurance, and other costs. All medical expenses not overed by the insurance plan are the sole responsibility of each student.
- 6. Violation of local laws committed in the host country could subject the exchange student to immediate withdrawal of his/her exchange sponsorship. The student could be sent home.
- 7. It is the sole responsibility of the home institution to decide how many credit units each student may actually receive on courses taken at the host institution.
- 8. This agreement shall be valid for a period of five years commencing on the date of its signing by the representatives of both universities. The agreement may be automatically renewed every five years, unless either party wishes to terminate the agreement. Renewal and termination of the agreement will be decided upon mutual consent.
- 9. This agreement is executed in duplicate in English, with both texts being equally authentic.
